WHAT WE ARE LEARNING

ELA: We finished learning about how schools compare and contrast around the world. We also learned all about quotations and proper nouns. We will start reading and learning about Helen Keller next week. Throughout this story, we will review author's purpose and explore biographies/autobiographies. Students are bringing home information about a 3rd marking period book report today featuring this genre as well! We will also start a new writing piece featuring fables!

Science: This week we learned all about river rocks and about rocks we can find even on our playground! We sorted by properties and experimented with rubbing the rocks to make rock dust and placing them in water. Next week, we will talk about how rocks vary by property (mostly size) and learn how to separate rock mixtures using screens.

Math: We still need a lot of practice with our basic facts. Some kiddos are still counting on their fingers and using a number line to solve basic addition and subtraction problems. Please practice at home. Thanks so much!! 😊
