

WELCOME TO THE FOURTH GRADE TEAM!

We would like to take this opportunity to say **welcome!**
4thGrade Rocks! ☺

We both would like to familiarize you with your child's new grade. Here are some essential school supplies that we are asking your child to have on the first day of school:

1. Six folders with **pockets and prongs** inside to hold loose-leaf paper. Our experience has been that the plastic folders tend to last a lot longer. **Please insert some paper in the prongs of all 6 folders.**
2. Two packages of loose-leaf notebook paper.
3. A one subject spiral notebook (70 pages)
4. A smock for art class **in a zip lock bag with their name on it**
5. 10 **sharpened** pencils (more throughout the year)
6. 2 red pens
7. 1 pencil bag
8. 1 box of crayons (24 count please)
9. 1 box of colored pencils (12 count)
10. 1 box of washable markers (8 count)
11. 1 highlighter
12. 1 bottle of glue (4 oz.)
13. 3 glue sticks
14. 1 dry erase marker
15. 1 package of eraser caps
16. A pair of school safe scissors (helpful, but not required)
17. 1 pair of ear buds in **a zip lock bag with their name on it**
18. A pocket folder for music class
19. Package of square/rectangular Post it notes (no odd shapes please)
20. 1 Marbled composition notebook

The school will be supplying your child with an assignment pad to record their daily homework. It will be a good idea to sit down with your child daily and check their homework pad, discuss their assignments, and help them schedule their time. During the first few days of school your child will be coming home with textbooks which will need to be covered. You may purchase book covers, but plain, brown grocery bags work great and are FREE.

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We also recommend that you keep on hand at home the following supplies:

- Loose-leaf paper
- Pencils-Lots of them!
- Crayons
- Glue sticks

PS: *mechanical pencils* are **not allowed** to be used in the classroom.
