In social studies we are wrapping up our Map studies

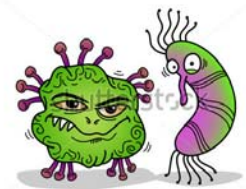


The current biography project books will count for this marking period as long as the reading is completed by Nov. 1st. It will also count toward their biography genre for Star Reader.
