## Breakfast - Lunch - Milk Order Form 2016-17

Children may purchase a balanced breakfast and lunch at a nominal cost. Milk is included with both. Ice cream and other snacks are available at lunch time for an extra charge. Children who choose to carry their own lunch may purchase half pints of milk also at a nominal cost.

Children buying may purchase multiple meals to be used over extended periods of time. Parents may now make this purchase online through the Parent Portal. Simply access the Food Services tab on the portal and click "make online payment". This is the preferred method of payment. If you do not wish to pay online, this order form with your payment should be placed in a sealed envelope and your child should turn it in to his/her homeroom teacher. Please make checks payable to Knowlton Twp. Elementary School. **No post dated checks please.**

The breakfast price is \$1.50. The lunch price this year is: \$2.75 each, 5 for \$13.75, 10 for \$27.50 or 20 for \$55.00, etc. **OUR SYSTEM ALLOWS YOU TO ADD ANY \$ AMOUNT TO A STUDENT'S ACCOUNT.** Breakfast and lunches purchased by the student will be subtracted from their account and parents will be notified by letter or phone message if the account goes into a negative balance. **Snacks may still be purchased with cash or may also be deducted from a student's account provided there is money in it.**

Milk Only purchases may be made by cash or by purchasing multiple milks and having it added to the student's account. The Milk Only cost is .45 cents each, 5 for \$2.25, etc.
