

# Parent Resources

## Income Self Sufficiency Programs:

- Work First New Jersey: Provides families and children with financial assistance and support services through the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families Program.
- Temporary Assistance for Needy Families – assistance for families who are struggling to provide basic needs such as financial, medical, and child care.
- Food Stamp Program: enable low income families and individuals to purchase a variety of nutritious food. Eligibility is based on income, resources and expenses.

## Medicaid Programs;

- New Jersey Care: provides medical coverage for pregnant women throughout the duration of the pregnancy and 60 days after birth.
- Family Care: provides free or low cost health coverage for uninsured children and teens 18 or younger. NJ Family Care is not a welfare program; it offers full health coverage through several recognized Health Maintenance Organizations. NJ Family Care covers doctor visits, eyeglasses, hospitalization, lab tests, x-rays, prescriptions, regular checkups, mental health and in most circumstances, dental.

County wide programs include residential, family support, advocacy, recreation and Special Olympics training, early intervention, case management and a wide variety of social services.

- Family Support Services – In home respite, specialized children’s programs, voucher program, are services designed to give families a “break” from often overwhelming responsibilities.
- Recreation Services and Camp Warren- Sports and socialization opportunities for children and adults with developmental disabilities.
- Community Living Arrangements – a wide variety of community based residential options are available to the adult with developmental disabilities.
- Social Services – information, advocacy, referral, prevention and education programs.
